Located in the Botanic Garden in Uppsala, the Swedish Collegium for Advanced Study (scas) is a national institute for advanced study. The Collegium offers short-term research stays (approximately two weeks to two months) to scholars from all countries.

The research stays give scholars the opportunity to concentrate on their own research interests, free from the teaching and administrative obligations of ordinary university life. Short-term researchers are, however, expected to be active members of the scholarly community of the Collegium and to participate in seminars and other academic events beyond their own fields of specialization. The collections of the Carolina Rediviva Library and other scientific facilities at Uppsala University are situated nearby the Collegium.

Short-term research stays are offered to individual scholars, as well as to small groups. The research stays are offered during the autumn and spring semesters.

The eligibility criteria differ between programmes, and between senior/early-career positions. For full details about the programmes, the eligibility criteria and how to apply, please see:
